PONIES (UK) SUPREME CHAMPIONSHIPS & WINTER CLASSIC

This show is a qualifier for the Ponies(UK) 2019 Spring Classic, Equifest 2018 & BSPA 2018, 1st 2nd and 3rd placed horses/ponies in each qualifying class will qualify
No membership is required to enter or compete in any Championship Final.

NORTHERN COUNTIES PONY ASSOCIATION

This show is a qualifier for the N.C.P.A. Pony of the Year Show. First and Second prize winners in appropriate classes will qualify. This show is a qualifier for the NCPA GOLDEN SUPREMES held in September 2018. Supreme Champion & Reserve prize winners will qualify from classes 71B & 71C.

THE NATIONAL PONY SOCIETY

NPS Qualifying Rounds: These classes are judged under the rules of the NPS. Ponies must be registered in the main body of their respective M & M stud books. Part bred are not eligible for M & M classes. To compete in show pony and show hunter pony classes ponies must be registered in the NPS british riding pony register, appendix, international or sports pony section of the BRPSB, the GSB, the AHSB, the AASB or in the main body of their respective M & M stud books, part bred are not eligible unless entered in the NPS british riding pony stud book, register, appendix, international or sports pony section of the BRPSB

Qualifying rounds for most NPS competitions are open to ponies owned by NPS members and non-members but only ponies owned by adult NPS Qualifying or life members are eligible to qualify for the final of the competition at the NPS Summer Championship Show at Malvern from 31st July – 2nd August 2018

The highest placed pony, if owned by an NPS member, in each class qualifies for the final. Qualification may pass down to third place if the first & second ponies are already qualified

NPS/Rosettes Direct Home Produced Ridden Championship – Riders of Home Produced ponies (see definition in the NPS Rule book) can wear a white arm band in classes where this is indicated. These ponies if owned by NPS members are then eligible to qualify for the final at the NPS Summer Championship Show. The Owner's Membership cards MUST be produced in the ring when requested or the qualification will be forfeit.

NPS Silver Medal Rosette Championship

These classes are to be judged under rules of the NPS. NPS silver medal rosettes are only awarded when the owner of the champion pony is a **qualifying or life** member of the NPS. A valid membership card must be in the riders/handler's possession on entering the ring and be produced immediately on request by either the judge or the steward. If the owner of the champion pony is not a member, or the owner's membership card is not immediately produced, the rosette may be awarded to the reserve champion provided they have the required membership card. If the champion pony has previously qualified it is still entitled to the silver medal rosette but the qualification goes to the reserve champion pony, provided the owner of that pony is a member of the NPS. The silver medal rosette and the qualification card can be awarded no lower than first reserve (third). Foals are not eligible for Silver Medal Championships. Qualifiers are entitled to compete in the final of the silver medal rosette championship to be held at the NPS summer championship show 31st July – 2nd August 2018.

EQUIFEST QUALIFIERS

The two highest placed exhibits not already qualified will qualify for the relevant Equifest Championship to be held at the East of England Showground on the 8th – 12th August 2018.

BRITISH SHOW PONY SOCIETY

This Show is affiliated to the British Show Pony Society (“B.S.P.S.”) and all persons entering, competing, showing or otherwise taking part in B.S.P.S. classes, whether or not members of the B.S.P.S. are subject to the Rules of the B.S.P.S., including the disciplinary procedures, and shall be deemed to have consented to the jurisdiction of the B.S.P.S.

This show is a qualifier for the 2018 B.S.P.S. Summer Championships Show, to be held at Arena UK. The 1st and 2nd prize-winners only in the following classes 80-81, 83-85, 87-90, 93, and the 1st, 2nd and 3rd prize-winners in class 92. The 1st, 2nd, 3rd and 4th prizewinners in classes 82, 91,94,95 will qualify for the B.S.P.S. Championships Show, provided the animal is registered in accordance to Rules 23 and 28 and ridden by a B.S.P.S. member.

This show is a qualifier for the BSPS Challenge, please see BSPS Rule 516 in the 2018 BSPS Rule & Show Handbook, the highest placed pony in the Open Lead Rein, First Ridden, Show Pony, Show Hunter Pony, Working Hunter Pony, Cradle and Nursery Stakes, Int WH heritage M & M Lead Rein, first ridden & ridden WHP. Animals must qualify for the challenge by attending any BSPS affiliating show and competing in the appropriate class. Ponies must **NOT** have qualified for the 2017 Horse of the Year Show in the appropriate class.

This show is a qualifier for the “BSPS Premier League”, the 1st 2nd 3rd & 4th placed ponies in the Lead Rein and First Ridden, 128cms, 138cms, and 148cm. Show Pony, Lead Rein of Hunter Type, 122cms 133cms, 143cms, & 153cms. Show Hunter Pony, Cradle and Nursery Stakes, 133cms, 143cms, & 153cms. Working Hunter Pony, Show Hunter & Working Hunter classes and the Open Heritage WHP classes, and 1st to 4th in mixed Height Open Classes.

This show is a qualifier for the BSPS Champion of Champions, the Champion Mini Show Pony, the Champion Mini WHP, the Champion Open Show Pony, the Champion Open WHP/WH and the Champion Open SHP. In the mixed height open classes, the 1st prize winner will qualify.

2. The Show is a private company limited by guarantee, Company Number 8805879 and shall operate in accordance with the Memorandum of Association and Articles of Association.
3. The Directors and Members shall be form the Show Committee (hereinafter called "The Committee"). The Committee shall have the power to fill any vacancy and have the power to elect any sub-committee they deem necessary.
4. The Directors shall be elected from the members, on a rolling programme to be determined by the current Directors and Members, at the Annual General Meeting in December of each year.
5. An Honorary President shall be elected annually at the Annual General Meeting of The Show to be held in December of each year and he/she shall assume office on the first day of January next following.
6. All past Presidents shall enjoy for life, the privileges given to former Presidents, at the annual show.
7. The Directors and Members of The Show can nominate Life Members whenever circumstances so demand.
8. The Committee shall manage the Show in its entirety and shall be responsible for altering any judging arrangements or event they may consider necessary.
9. The Committee will not accept responsibility for any accident or accidental damage that may occur involving competitors, exhibitors or members of the public whilst entering or leaving the Show field or on the Show field itself. It shall be considered a condition of entry that any competitor or exhibitor shall not hold the Show responsible in the event of any accident or accidental damage and that condition of entry shall be considered to indemnify the Show against any legal proceedings arising from such circumstance.
10. Completed and signed entry forms, together with entry fees, must be in the hands of the Secretaries on or before the date shown in the schedule (with the exception of sections where entries are to be made on the day of the Show as shown in the Schedule).
11. The Show will not be held responsible for any losses, mistakes or accidents that may occur in any entry and all entries are received subject to this condition.
12. The Committee reserve the right to reject any entries and to return the entry fees.
13. The Committee reserve the right to cancel any class in which there are no more than three entries. The Committee will meet within one week of the date on which entries close and exhibitors in any class that is cancelled will be notified immediately after the meeting and have their entry fee refunded.

17. All Champions and first and second prize winners to parade in the ring.
18. Any dispute or protest related to any prize or result shall be made to the Secretaries, in writing, no later than 4 p.m. on the day of the show. The matter will be referred to the Committee whose decision on the matter will be final and binding on all interested parties.
19. In the event of unfavorable weather or unforeseen circumstances beyond the control of the organisation, the Committee are empowered to postpone or cancel the Show and will not hold themselves responsible for any expenses which might be incurred by any competitors or exhibitors.
20. All exhibits to be the property of the exhibitor and are to have been in his or her ownership at least one month prior to the date of the Show.
21. No betting allowed in connection with any events.
22. Except where otherwise stated all trophies are perpetual, cannot be won outright and will be held until 31st May following the show at which they were won, unless recalled earlier by the show. The trophies must be returned in a sound and clean condition. Failure to return trophies will result in the Exhibitor concerned being refused entry to future shows run by the North Yorkshire County Agricultural Show.
23. The Committee will not be responsible for any charges incurred by exhibitors for conveyance or delivery of exhibits to and from the show.
24. The foregoing Rules shall only be altered or added to by an Annual General Meeting or a General Meeting of Members duly convened for such a purpose. These rules are in addition to the Articles of Association which are the overriding legal rules.
25. By entering the North Yorkshire Country Agricultural Show the exhibitor is agreeing that his/her name and location will be entered into and published in the list of competitors (full address details will be held on a database).
