

# EQUINE INFLUENZA NOTICE

Horses must have been vaccinated to comply with the requirements of the primary course (1<sup>st</sup> vaccination and then 2<sup>nd</sup> vaccination between 21 – 92 days later), followed by the first booster (150 – 215 days) and all subsequent boosters. Horses may compete having received the primary course and prior to the first booster but not within 7 days of receiving a vaccine dose.

Horses must have been vaccinated within 6 months before the show but not less than 7 days of arriving at the show.

## Foals

In-foal mares that have already had vaccinations of primary Equine Influenza course should be vaccinated 4-6 weeks before the foal is due to be born.

Foals should be vaccinated for Equine Influenza at 6 months to commence their primary course.

We urge all owners to adhere to strict biosecurity protocols at all times.

Vaccinations are subject to local risk assessments by the attending veterinarians.

## RULES OF THE SHOW

1. Prize money may be withdrawn/or reduced depending on the amount of catalogued entries in a class. Ridden prize money: If 6 or less exhibits catalogued prize money will only be awarded to 2nd place. For all in hand classes prize money will be awarded as follows:- three entries or less 1st prize only, four or five entries 1st and 2nd prize and 6 or more entries 1st 2nd and 3rd prize only
2. If deemed necessary, the organizers may use alternative judges to the ones stated in this schedule
3. Competitors should be aware of the wording of the societies rules that they compete under, the Show Committee will not be held responsible for any misunderstanding regarding these rules
4. Entry fees will only be refunded with a valid vet or medical certificate produced BEFORE show day, minus a 10% admin fee.
5. The Show Society reserves the right to measure any animal at any time
6. Closing dates for entries is 18<sup>th</sup> May 2019. Some late entries maybe accepted at the Light Horse Secretaries discretion
7. Failure to return trophies will result in the exhibitor concerned being refused entry to this and any future shows that are run by North Yorkshire County Agricultural Show.
8. The organisers of this show have taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring, and must obey the instructions of the organisers, officials and stewards.
9. Any judge change after this schedule has been printed will be notified on our website.
10. All exhibitors must have adequate public liability insurance
11. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to check if the show is still taking place due to bad weather.
12. All prize money, prizes and cups to be collected on the show day, nothing to be sent out after the show day
13. The organisers reserve the right to cancel or amalgamate any classes

### **NORTHERN COUNTIES PONY ASSOCIATION**

This show is a qualifier for the N.C.P.A. Pony of the Year Show. First and Second prizewinners in appropriate classes will qualify. This show is a qualifier for the NCPA GOLDEN SUPREMES held in September 2019. Supreme Champion & Reserve prize winners will qualify from the supreme in hand and supreme ridden.

### **THE NATIONAL PONY SOCIETY**

NPS Qualifying Rounds: These classes are judged under the Rules of the NPS. Ponies must be registered in the main body of their respective Mountain & Moorland Stud Books. Part bred are not eligible for Mountain & Moorland Classes. To compete in Show Pony and Show Hunter Pony classes ponies must be registered in the NPS British Riding Pony Stud Book, Register, Appendix, International or Sports Pony section of the BRPSB, the GSB, the AHSB, the AASB or in the main body of their respective Mountain & Moorland Stud Books. Part-Breds are not eligible unless entered in the NPS British Riding Pony Stud Book, Register, Appendix, International or Sports Pony section of the BRPSB.

Qualifying rounds for most NPS competitions are open to ponies owned by NPS members and non-members but only ponies owned by adult NPS Qualifying or Life members are eligible to qualify for the final of the competition at the NPS Summer Championship Show at Malvern from 6th – 8th August 2019

The highest placed pony, if owned by an NPS member, in each class will qualify for the final.

Qualification may pass down to third place if the first and second ponies are already qualified.

NPS/Rosettes Direct Home Produced Ridden Championship - Riders of Home Produced ponies (see definition in the NPS Rules Book) can wear a white arm band in classes where this is indicated.

These ponies, if owned by NPS members, are then eligible to qualify for the final at the NPS Summer Championship Show. The Owner's Membership cards MUST be produced in the ring when requested or the qualification will be forfeit.

### **NPS Silver Medal Rosette Championship**

These classes are judged under the Rules of the NPS. NPS Silver Medal Rosettes are only awarded when the owner of the champion pony is a Qualifying or Life member of the NPS. A valid membership card must be in the rider's/handler's possession on entering the ring and be produced immediately on request by either the judge or the steward. If the owner of the Champion pony is not a member, or the owner's membership card is not immediately produced, the rosette may be awarded to the Reserve Champion provided they have the required membership card. If the Champion pony has previously qualified it is still entitled to the Silver Medal Rosette, but the qualification card goes to the Reserve Champion pony, provided the owner of that pony is a member of the NPS. The Silver Medal Rosette and the qualification card can be awarded no lower than first Reserve (third). Foals are not eligible for Silver Medal Championships.

### **EQUIFEST QUALIFIERS**

The two highest placed exhibits not already qualified will qualify for the relevant Equifest Championship to be held at the East of England Showground on the 29<sup>th</sup> August to 1<sup>st</sup> September 2019.

### **IRISH DRAUGHT HORSE SOCIETY**

The following classes are affiliated to the Irish Draught Horse Society (GB) and only horses registered with or over stamped by the IDHS (GB) and in the correct ownership are eligible for entry. All Pure Bred Breeding and Youngstock In-hand exhibits must be the progeny of a Graded Mare ( ID Class1, Class 2, RID (GB), AID or Supplementary Grade Up Register) and be by a Class 1, Class 2 or RID (GB) stallion on the Irish Draught Breed Register. All Sport Horses must be registered on the Irish Draught Sport Horse Register. The owners of all pure-bred Irish Draught horses in both In-hand and ridden classes must be full members of the IDHS(GB), This rule does not apply to the owners of Irish draught sporthorses. Registration numbers to be stated on the entry form and entries will be sent to the IDHS (GB) prior to the Show to confirm eligibility.

\* A Graded MARE or FILLY is one that has been inspected or over stamped by the IDHS (GB) and passed into one of the following categories: ID Class 1, ID Class 2, RID, AID or the Supplementary Grade Up Register.

In the interest of safety, all Yearling, Two and Three year old COLTS must be bitted and shown by an experienced handler of 18 years of age or over and all riders of STALLIONS must be 18 years of age or over.

All competing STALLIONS must be inspected or over stamped by the IDHS (GB) and classified as RID (GB), ID Class 1 or ID Class 2 OR Irish Draught Sport Horse and must display a red, white and blue ribbon in their tails.

All ridden horses must be 153cm (15hh) or over.

“This show is a Qualifier for the Blue Chip & Irish Draught Horse Society (GB) £2,000 Challenge. The highest placed horse (not already qualified) from Class 25 that is registered or eligible for registration on the Irish Draught or Irish Draught Sport Horse Register, i.e. with a minimum of 25% proven Irish Draught breeding, will qualify for the Final of the Blue Chip & IDHS (GB) £2,000 Challenge. Horses need not be registered with the Irish Draught Horse Society (GB) to qualify but must be on the IDHS (GB) Registers by the time of the Championship which will be held at the IDHS (GB) Annual Breed Show on 17th & 18th August 2019 at Arena UK, Grantham, Lincolnshire. NG32 2EF. N.B: A horse may only qualify for the Final once, regardless of the type or number of classes won, placed in or entered. Each qualifier will receive a card and a £10 voucher from Blue Chip. Qualifiers are required to complete an online form at [www.idhsgb.com](http://www.idhsgb.com) to inform the IDHS (GB) that they have qualified for the Final. In the Final, the Champion will be awarded £1,000 prize money, a trophy and a Blue Chip rug. The Reserve Champion will be awarded £500 and 3rd to 7th inclusive will be awarded £100 each. In addition, the highest placed Pure Bred Irish Draught will receive a trophy and £100, the highest placed 158cm (15.2hh) and under will receive a trophy and £50, the highest placed Sport Horse will receive a trophy and £50 and the highest placed \*Amateur Produced and Ridden Horse will receive a silver salver and a rug.”

This show is a Qualifier for the The Moorbennhall Irish Draught Youngstock Challenge.

The two highest placed Pure Breds from each age group that have not already qualified – yearlings, two year olds and three year olds - eligible for Class 1 of the Irish Draught Breed Register by an RID (GB), ID Class 1 or ID Class 2 sire out of a Graded\* dam will qualify to go forward to the Final at the IDHS (GB) Annual Breed Show on 17th & 18th August 2019 at Arena UK, Allington, Grantham, Lincolnshire, NG32 2EF. Each qualifier will receive a card. Qualifiers are required to complete an online form at [www.idhsgb.com](http://www.idhsgb.com) to inform the IDHS (GB) that they have qualified for the Final. In the Final, there will be three preliminary classes with the two highest placed semi-finalists from each class will go forward to the Championship where the Champion will receive £500 and the Reserve Champion £150

### **BRITISH SHOW PONY SOCIETY**

This Show is affiliated to the British Show Pony Society (“B.S.P.S.”) and all persons entering, competing, showing or otherwise taking part in B.S.P.S. classes, whether or not members of the B.S.P.S. are subject to the Rules of the B.S.P.S., including the disciplinary procedures, and shall be deemed to have consented to the jurisdiction of the B.S.P.S.

This show is a qualifier for the 2019 B.S.P.S. Summer Championships Show, to be held at Arena UK. The 1st and 2nd prize-winners only in classes 79-81, 84-87 and 89 and the 1st, 2nd and 3rd prize-winners in class 88. The 1st, 2nd, 3rd and 4th prizewinners in classes 92 will qualify for the B.S.P.S. Championships Show, provided the animal is registered in accordance to Rules 21 and 26 and ridden by a B.S.P.S. member.

This show is a qualifier for the BSPS Classic Security (UK) Ltd Challenge, Please see BSPS Rule 516 in the 2019 BSPS Rule & Show Handbook, the highest placed pony in the Open Lead Rein, First Ridden, Show Pony, Show Hunter Pony, Working Hunter Pony, Cradle and Nursery Stakes, Int WH heritage M & M Lead Rein, First ridden & ridden WHP. Animals must qualify for the challenge by attending any BSPS affiliating show and competing in the appropriate class. Ponies must NOT have qualified for the 2019 Horse of the Year Show in the appropriate class,

This show is a qualifier for the BSPS White Company 50th Year Anniversary Mini WHP Champion of Champions. 1st prize winners in Open Cradle and Nursery Stakes will qualify.

This show is a qualifier for the BSPS Binks Family 50th Year Golden Anniversary Show Champion of Champions. 1st prize winners in the Open Lead Rein, First Ridden, Open Show Pony, Open WHP, Open SHP, Open LRHT, Open intermediate SH, SRT and WH and Open Heritage Lead Rein, First Ridden, Ridden and WHP classes.
