Entries may be submitted from the 2021/22 academic year.

Name and school to be written on the reverse of each entry.

All entries to be the unaided work of the competitor.

The rules and regulations printed in the main schedule also apply.

In each class points will be awarded as follows:-

1st 4 points £2.00

2nd 3 points £1.50

3rd 2 points £1.00

4th 1 point (no prize money)

Prize money for Class 524 (Group Collage) is as follows 1st £20 2nd £10 3rd £5

The North Yorkshire County Show Junior Cup will be awarded to the exhibitor aged 11 years and under on 31st August 2022 who gains the most points overall in the Junior Schedule. The trophy will be held for one year.

The North Yorkshire County Show Perpetual Trophy Challenge Trophy will be awarded to the exhibitor aged 12-16 years who gains the most overall points in the Junior Schedule. The trophy will be held for one year.

North Yorkshire County Show Collage Trophy will be presented to the winning entry in Class 548 and held for one year.
